I. Outstanding Professional:

1. WSTRA member, NCTRC certified, WA state registered, 7+ years TR-related experience.
2. Meritorious lifetime contributions to TR advancement with distinguished service and exemplary leadership.

II. Outstanding Program/Protocol:

1. Innovative, unique program/protocol for TR treatment, education or recreation provision.
2. Created, developed, organized, administered, implemented within WA state by or under supervision of appropriately credentialed TR professionals.
3. Driven by demonstrated consumer need.

III. Professional Member of the Year:

1. WSTRA member, appropriate credentials.
2. Exceptional WSTRA contribution during preceding year.

IV. Student Member of the Year:

1. WSTRA student member, resident of or attending school in WA state.
2. Enrolled full-time TR student, $\geq 2.5/4.0$ overall GPA, $\geq 3.0/4.0$ or higher TR GPA
3. Exceptional contribution to WSTRA and school during preceding year.

V. Clinical TR Specialist of the Year:

1. NCTRC certified, WA state registered, 2+ years TR experience in a clinical setting.
2. Exemplary contribution to clinical TR during preceding year.

VI. Community TR Specialist of the Year:

1. NCTRC certified, 2+ years TR experience in a community setting.
2. Exemplary contribution to community TR during preceding year.

VII. Volunteer of the Year:

1. 2+ years voluntary service to a TR-related program or organization in WA state.
2. Excellent dependability and demonstrated empathy, caring and sensitivity.
3. Outstanding contributions to TR and program/organization served during preceding year.

VIII. Commendation of Merit:

1. Resided, worked or organized within WA state.
2. Organization supports TR or provides TR-related services. Person not a WSTRA member or TR-related volunteer.
3. Exemplary contributions to WSTRA or TR in the last 5 years.

IX. Special Merit:

1. Unusual or remarkable TR-related achievement not within an above category.
